 - Identify short- and midterm opportunities for collaboration in improving MRO
 - Turn these opportunities in to actionable projects
 - Follow up is key
 - Connection to Nationaal Collectief Businessplan





Roadmap MRO (2)

- Approach
 - Survey to the NAG-members for this

 - Questionnaire during the MRO Europe in Amsterdam (University of Applied Sciences)







Preliminary results: Some highlights

- Developments
 - Digitalization and automation
 - E.g. automated inspections
 - Predictive maintenance
 - Data analysis
 - Artificial Intelligence
 - Training using VR and AR
- Challenges
 - Personnel shortage & qualifications
 - Image problem of civil Aerospace
 - Collaboration [with OEM]
 - Competition with low wage countries
